Scott also, is having to cover the Monticello office, and they also have around 100 EQIP applications with one employee. How all the work is going to get done we have no idea.

There is a Senate Bill proposed concerning soil and water conservation districts. We are expecting a House Bill soon, that's the one that we need to keep our eye on.
